

Message from Board of Regents Chair Ken Powell

This morning, Joan Gabel shared with all of us that she will be leaving the University of Minnesota to become the next chancellor of the University of Pittsburgh. Her new position begins in July and she has expressed to me her commitment to use the months we have before then to ensure the smoothest possible leadership transition for our University.

Since joining the University of Minnesota in 2019 as our 17th president, Joan has led the University through some of the most challenging years in its history. She expertly navigated a global pandemic and its continued disruptions, through a time of both seismic shifts in higher education and great change here in Minnesota. Despite those challenges, she charted a course for the U of M's future by developing MPact 2025, our comprehensive systemwide strategic plan, to set clear goals and expectations for how we all will further strengthen our mission-driven work.
