Fire Chief Butch Inks and the Saint Paul Fire Department along with the family and friends of Fire Captain Chris Parsons will be paying their final respects and laying Captain Parsons to rest.

Captain Parsons joined the department in 2000 and was promoted to Captain in 2007. Besides being a dedicated member of the Saint Paul Fire Department, he has also served as a Chair Officer for IAFF Local 21, President of the Minnesota Professional Fire Fighters, and a board member of the MN Fire Service Foundation. Through his many years of service, Chris had an impact on many residents and visitors to the city of Saint Paul, along with his impactful work on legislation at the state capitol benefiting firefighters and first responders. Captain Parsons sustained a major medical event following shift, his passing will be recognized as Minnesota Type I Line of Duty Death. Chris is incredibly well known and respected, a good friend to many and will be missed by all.

Service arrangements were made by Chris's daughters and family in coordination with Washburn and McReavy Funeral Home. The fire department will participate in the Active Member MN Type I Line of Duty Death (LODD) service for Fire Captain Chris Parsons.
